

Baylor County Appraisal District Board of Directors Primary Responsibilities

- Establish the appraisal districts appraisal office.
- Adopt the appraisal district's annual operating budget.
- Contract for necessary services.
- Appoint appraisal review board members and other committees provided by law.
- Provide advice and consent to the chief appraiser concerning the appointment of an agricultural appraisal advisor board and determine the number of members to that advisory board.
- Approve contract with appraisal firms selected by the chief appraiser to perform appraisal services for the district.
- Make general policies on the appraisal district's operation.
- Biennially develop a written plan for the periodic reappraisal of all property within the district's boundaries.
